International Competition of Composition for Nacchinian Organ (III ed.)

REGULATIONS

Art. 1

In celebration of the great organ-maker Pietro Nacchini, Venice's Scuola Grande di San Rocco is announcing the Third International Competition of Composition for Nacchinian Organ.

Art. 2

The competition is open to musicians of all nationalities born after the 1st of January 1989. It is structured into two sections: Solo Organ, and Organ and Choir.

Each participant must present only one composition in any style or form, which must be entirely original and have minimum duration 7 [seven] minutes and maximum 15 [fifteen]. The composition must be unreleased, never before performed or recorded, nor submitted into other competitions, nor ever published through any media, social or otherwise.

The composition must include one of the following instrument set-up:

- solo organ
- organ and three- or four-voices mixed choir [SATB or SAB]

Art. 3

Every composition entered into the competition must draw inspiration from the motet "O Salutaris Ostia" by Giovanbattista Tosini, which is preserved in the Archive of the Scuola Grande di San Rocco (see attachment). Furthermore, in order to ensure that it will be possible to perform the score fully, the following specification of the organ of the San Rocco church in Venice must be considered.

Built in 1743 by Pietro Nacchini in a wooden case on a stone organ loft located on the counter-façade; restored in 1997 by Franz Zanin.

Keyboard of 45 notes [C₁-C₅] with first short octave [that is without C#, D#, F# and

G#]. Pedalboard with 17 notes [C₁-G#₂] with first short octave, permanently linked to the manual.

Bass/discant division: C₃-C#₃.

Slider wind chest.

Manual wind system with electric blower.

Tuned with unequal temperament.

Diapason: A₃=450 Hz

Principale (8') Voce umana (from C#₃)

Ottava Flauto in XII

Quintadecima Cornetta (from C#₃)

Decimanona

Vigesimaseconda

Vigesimasesta

Vigesimanona

Contrabbassi (pedal stop, constantly inserteted)

Hand-cranked recall for Ripieno stops

Art. 4

Compositions must be submitted anonymously, accompanied only by a personal motto of the composer, under penalty of exclusion from the competition. They must be sent via email, in PDF format, to the following address: snrocco@libero.it. From this address, the material will be sent to the members of the selection board in anonymous form.

Compositions must be submitted within and not later than midnight on the 27th of September 2024.

All material must be submitted in perfectly readable PDF format and audio of good resolution. For audio files we suggest MP3 format (at 44.1 KHz stereo and resolution not less than 192 kbps), or WAV files (at 44.1 KHz); should the files exceed a total size of 5 Mbytes, they must be transmitted via the free online service WeTransfer. The digital files, both PDF and audio, must not be signed and must not contain any identifying data in the "file properties" section, under penalty of exclusion from the competition at the unquestionable discretion of the commission; the files must bear as their name only the motto chosen by the candidate to identify his/her own composition (the same motto for PDF and audio).

The compositions may be accompanied by a short technical-illustrative introduction, which mustn't contain any elements indicating the identity of the author.

If any unusual symbols or graphic characters are used, the author must provide a suitable explanatory key. The compositions will not be returned, but will be kept in the Scuola Grande's archive.

Each composition must have a title, which must not contain the name of the author or any elements which may help in identifying him/her.

Art. 5

In order to qualify for the competition, participants must also send, separately from the composition and abiding by the terms of the previous art. 4, the following:

- application form with handwritten signature

- copy of a valid form of ID
- a recent photo
- artistic curriculum
- indication of title and motto identifying the composition
- receipt for payment of the application fee of € 70,00 [seventy], to be paid by bank transfer to the Scuola Grande Arciconfraternita di San Rocco, IBAN: IT55P0503402196000000009922, indicating the reason as 'Nacchini Competition Application'

Art. 7

The jury, within 45 days from the deadline, will select the 6 [six] winning compositions for the first, second and third prize, respectively three in the solo organ section and three in the organ and choir section.

The title of the winning compositions will be published on the Scuola Grande di San Rocco website in the days immediately following the deadline mentioned above.

The first three classified compositions of each section will be awarded the following prizes, in addition to a certificate:

- First prize: € 1500 and gold medal of the Scuola Grande di San Rocco
- Second prize: € 1000 and silver medal of the Scuola Grande di San Rocco
- Third prize: € 500 and bronze medal of the Scuola Grande di San Rocco.
- Special Prize of the Conservatorio "Benedetto Marcello", which will be awarded on the recommendation of the Director of the Institute and will consist in the performance of the winning piece in a concert on the Franz Zanin organ in the Concert Hall of the Conservatorio "Benedetto Marcello", Venice.

The compositions that win first prize in both sections will be published.

The winning compositions will be included in the Albo d'Oro of the Competition, published online on the Scuola Grande di San Rocco website.

Art. 8

In the event of verifiable academic or didactic relations between a candidate and a board member for the period from 1 January 2022 to the competition deadline, the board member's vote will be excluded from the overall assessment of the candidate.

Art. 9

Applications from those who have won First Prize in any competition class in previous editions will not be accepted

Art. 10

The assessment of the selection board will be final and irrevocable. The selection board also reserves the right not to award any prizes if no compositions are deemed worthy.

Art. 11

Entering the competition implies full acceptance of all norms listed above.
